

## Champagne and Sparkling Wine

### 1. PROSECCO SPUMANTE, TENUTA CA'BOLANI, NV

Italy

Bottle: £29.00

200ml Bottle: £8.00

*Pale straw-yellow and a fine, clear mousse with delicate bubbles. Exuberantly fruity and aromatic, with appley notes. Well-balanced and easy-drinking with the delicate almond note typical of the grape variety. (1) 11% vol.*

### 2. CAMEL VALLEY BRUT, 2013/14

Camel Valley, Cornwall, England

Bottle: £47.00

*Superb golden sparkler with elegant fizz and full, ripe flavours, packed with elderflower and hedgerow notes, yet truly brut. (1) 12.5% vol.*

### 3. AYALA BRUT, NV

Champagne, France

Bottle: £52.00

*Light yellow. Expressive, fruity nose primarily recalling ripe apple with a faint tangy touch. Lovely personality, freshness, character and fairly persistent, focused aromas on the palate. (1) 12.5% vol.*

### 4. BOLLINGER SPECIAL CUVÉE BRUT, NV

Champagne, France

Bottle: £65.00

*Firm, with yeasty brioche notes following through to enrich the fruit flavour. Taut style and solid finish. (1) 12% vol.*

### 5. BOLLINGER ROSÉ BRUT, NV

Champagne, France

Bottle: £75.00

*Created from 62% Pinot Noir, 24% Chardonnay and 14% Pinot Meunier, in the meticulous House style, Bollinger Rosé shows delicate aromas of ripe red fruits, and powerful elegance. Difficult to analyse, it is both bullish and has the finesse of classical ballet. It is immensely complex - tightly wound like a coiled spring - and utterly wonderful. (1) 12% vol.*

6. ESENCIA DE FONTANA, VERDEJO, 2014/15 £5.00 £7.00 £19.50

Uclés, Spain

*Aromatic nose with notes of freshly cut hay, white pepper and fennel. Light-bodied, but with excellent fruit concentration. Slightly mineral with a crisp, dry finish. 12% vol.*

7. LAROMA, BOTTER, PINOT GRIGIO, 2014/15 £5.00 £7.00 £19.50

Venezie, Italy

*Fresh, dry and delicate with gentle floral and citrus aromas. A classic Italian white wine. 12% vol.*

8. HONORES DE BERTICOT, SAUVIGNON BLANC, 2015/16 £21.00

IGP de L'Atlantique, France

*Grassy, dry Sauvignon from western France, with a pleasing, crisp, neat finish. 12% vol.*

9. LA BAURNE GRANDE OLIVETTE, VIOGNIER, 2014/15 £22.00

Languedoc, France

*Bright straw yellow colour with powerful peachy aromas that leap from the glass. Mandarin zest, fresh apricot and candied orange vie for attention on the palate, full-bodied flavours that develop into a fresh and spicy finish. 14% vol.*

10. BUTTERBALL, EVANS & TATE, CHARDONNAY, 2014/15 £23.00

Western, Australia

*A full bodied and flavoursome wine, ripe and intensely flavoured fruit aged in premium French oak creating a mouth-filling combination of rich peach, melon and cashew flavours interwoven with buttery elements and subtle oak. 13% vol.*

11. DENOMINACION ORIGEN CALIFICADA, RIOJA MUGA, 2015 £24.50

Rioja, Spain

*Complex and toasted aromas with fresh, vibrant fruits give way to zesty lime, spicy and vanillin toasted oak flavours, fresh acidity, and a refreshing spicy finish. 13.5% vol.*

12. FINCAS DE AZABACHE, RIOJA, TEMPRANILLO BLANCO, 2015/16 £25.00

Rioja, Spain

*White Tempranillo is a 'new' grape variety but closely linked to the well-known red Tempranillo grown all over Spain. This style is robust yet unoaked, with apple refreshment and elegantly balanced. 12% vol.*

13. CHATEAU DE LA PRESLE, VAL DE LOIRE, TOURAINE SAUVIGNON, 2015 £25.50

Loire, France

*Chateau de la Presle is very New World in style. Reminiscent of an excellent New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc, it has a zippy acidic structure and bright flavours of grapefruit, tropical fruit, green pepper, and fresh grass. 13.5% vol.*

14. GUERILLA, ALBARIÑO, 2015/16 £28.00

Rias Baixas, Spain

White fruit aromas reminiscent of melon and pear on the nose precede an explosive palate with well-balanced acidity. 12.5% vol.

15. MÂCON-VILLAGES, ROPITEAU, 2013/14 £29.00

Burgundy, France

Rich golden in colour, this wine is elegant yet expressive. Flavours of lemon and mint provide fresh balance with soft, floral honeysuckle notes giving a roundness to the finish. (1) 12.5% vol.

16. SAUVIGNON BLANC, SPY VALLEY, 2015/16 £31.00

Marlborough, New Zealand

Luscious, ripe, creamy vanilla nose over classic gooseberry fruit with notes of green pepper. Brilliantly crisp and racy with a ripe intensity of fruit and bursting with vitality through the immense citrus fruit. (2) 13% vol.

17. SANCERRE, DOMAINE NEVEU, 2014/15 £35.00

Loire, France

A classic wine from the historical home of Sauvignon. Not only does it have an elegant 'gunflint' minerality, but the grassy, gooseberry fruit carries through the citrus richness. (1) 12.5% vol.

18. CHABLIS 1ER CRU LES VAUDEVAY, DOMAINE LAROCHE, 2014/15 £48.00

Chablis, Burgundy, France

The elegant biscuit and brioche aroma is fitting of its 'Premier Cru' status. There is fine fruit flavour with the merest hint of oak to round out the citrus notes and extend the finish. (2) 13% vol.

19. PULIGNY-MONTRACHET, LOUIS CARILLON ET FILS, 2011 £70.00

Côte de Beaune, Burgundy, France

Intensely scented fruit and soft oak nose. Superbly integrated flavours from this top flight producer, finding lemon dash in the smoothest fruit imaginable. (2) 13.5% vol.

20. CORETO ROSADO, 2015/16 £5.00 £7.00 £19.50

Lisboa, Portugal

Award-winning wine for its intense fruity aromas, mouth-watering juiciness and crisp fresh flavours of strawberries and raspberries. A great all-rounder rosé for drinking with or without food. 12% vol.

21. SABLES D'AZUR ROSÉ, 2015/16 £23.50

Côtes de Provence, France

Classic Côtes de Provence rosé. Salmon coloured, elegant nose of white flowers, summer fruits and citrus with crisp acidity and delicate finish. 13% vol.

24. AVES DEL SUR, MERLOT RESERVE, 2013/14 Maule Valley, Chile <i>Intense red purple colour with some blue reflections. 25. TOR DEL COLLE, BOTTER, MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO RISERVA, 2013/14 Abruzzo, Italy <i>Intense and concentrated on the nose with cherry flavours and notes of blackberries and liquorice. Dry and herbaceous on the palate, rounded and mouth-filling. 13.5% vol.</i>			£22.00
26. LAURENT MIQUEL, SYRAH-GRENACHE, 2014/15 Languedoc, France <i>Smokey, spicy and herby with plenty of attractive hedgerow fruit flavours and good, solid weight. An almost chalky minerality that begs to be matched with robust food. 13% vol.</i>			£23.00
27. MISTERIO, FINCA FLICHMAN, MALBEC, 2014/15 Mendoza, Argentina <i>Aged in oak for four months, this is a chunky but smooth Malbec from renowned producer Finca Flichman. Soft, sweet tannins, blackberry fruit, tobacco and violet flavours meld together leaving an elegant and complex finishing note. 13.5% vol.</i>			£25.00
28. TARINGI, PINOT NOIR, 2013/14 Marlborough, New Zealand <i>Deliciously scented with ripe berry fruit. Smooth tannins and a touch of spice provide texture to a fruit-led palate. 12.5% vol.</i>			£30.00
29. LA PETITE RUCHE, M. CHAPOUTIER, CROZES HERMITAGE, 2014/15 Rhône, France <i>Red fruits, blackcurrant and raspberry aromas, fresh and rounded with a baked fruit note on the palate. Very fine and elegant. 13% vol.</i>			£41.00

30. ARS ROMÁNTICA, DE BARDOS, 2011/12 £30.00  
Ribera del Duero, Spain  
*Deep cherry red with an attractive nose full of dark fruit and liquorice. Black hedgerow fruits precede a full bodied palate with perfectly polished tannins. (D) 14% vol.*
31. GRENACHE, OLD VINE, SIMON HACKETT, 2012/13 £31.00  
McLaren Vale, Australia  
*Simon Hackett's old Grenache vines deliver these intensely juicy summer fruit characters. The flavours in this brilliant wine are smoothly ripe and touched with spice. (D) 14% vol.*
32. SHIRAZ, ROCKY ROAD, MCHENRY HOHNEN, 2013/14 £32.00  
Margaret River, Australia  
*Perhaps this is the perfect sleek and glossy Shiraz - smooth with richly spiced flavours, mouth-filling that run on forever. (D) 14.5% vol.*
33. HAUTES CÔTES DE BEAUNE, DOMAINE CHANSON, 2012/13 £44.00  
Burgundy, France  
*True Burgundy quality has been given to this young Hautes Côtes - a real over-performer in its class with vibrant fruit and absolute depth. (C) 12% vol.*
34. CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE, COLOMBO & FILLE, 2012/13 £49.00  
Rhône, France  
*A big wine intense colour, nose and palate. Ripe fruit and gingerbread notes with a touch of typical local herbs. (B) 14% vol.*
35. NUITS-ST-GEORGES, LOUIS LATOUR, 2013/14 £64.00  
Burgundy, France  
*Ripe cassis and black cherry fruit aromas. Classic earthy character with long, elegant finish showing a rich vanilla flavour. (C) 13.5% vol.*
36. CHÂTEAU PHÉLAN SÉGUR, 2010 £82.00  
St.Estèphe, Bordeaux, France  
*A wine for the dining table, it is packed with fresh, ripe, juicy blackcurrants, liquorice, earth, coffee and spice. There is a quality of softness to the tannins in the long, fresh, round finish that make this Merlot dominated blend of 59% Merlot and 41% Cabernet Sauvignon worth seeking out. (C) 14% vol.*
